

## Ford Charging

All Ford In-Network charger must be activated through your dashboard console. Please be advised that driver will need to stop charging the van once the charge reaches 80%. Charging from 80% to 100% adds additional 30 minute to the charge duration. Using DC Fast Charger to charge from 80% to 100% could also potentially hurt the battery.

### 1. Public Charging

- Go to App page
- Click on Charge Assist
- Filter by the following
  - o DC Fast Charger (**Ultrafast**)
  - o Confirmed Available Chargers
  - o In-Network Ford Network
- Activate the charger once you get to the location
- Take the connector out of the holster on the station and connect the charging port to the vehicle. When finished, remove the connector, and put back into the charging station holster.

### 2. Public Charger Bandwidth and Brands

- Ford E-Transit is equipped with a 68-kW rated battery.
  - o **Filter**
    - **Ultrafast (150kWh-350kWh) – 30-40min**
      - **EVGO**
      - **Electrify America**

3. Once you're done charging, make sure to move the vehicle so other customer can access the charger.
